Introduction and Objectives:

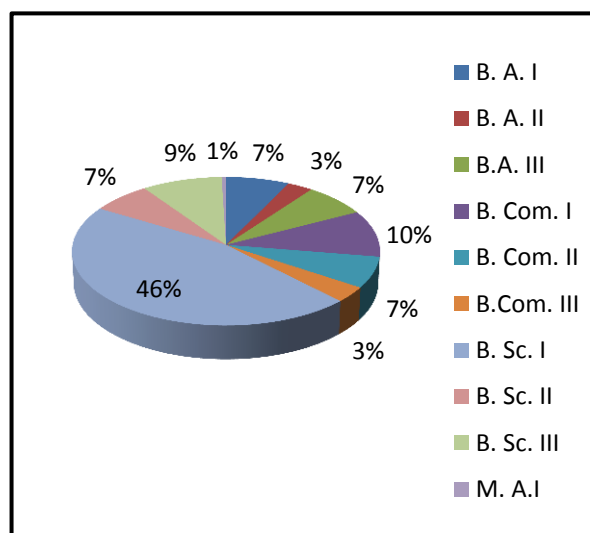
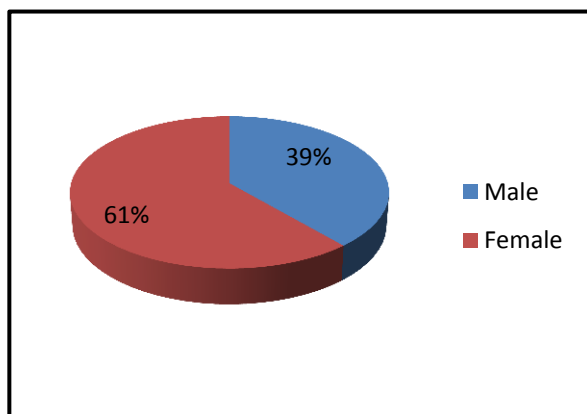
Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, **Prof. Dr. N. D. Patil Mahavidyalaya, Malkapur** was established in the year 1992. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. IQAC of the college was conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey regarding Teaching – Learning and Evaluation which will help to upgrade the quality in higher education. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these students is important as both are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the provision. Listening to what student say is a contributing factor in running a successful college or institution. This survey was developed to capture students' evaluation about teacher, facilities and curriculum related issues.

Methodology

In every academic year, we ask our students to fill a Students Satisfaction Survey form (SSS) which is made available on college website. Filling of SSS is voluntary/ optional. For the academic year 2022-23, there were 759 registered students at the college. This year data was collected during the period 1st May to 30th June 2023. The link of SSS form also made available to students on their email address, whatsapp address and college website. Two hundred and seven (207) students responded to the survey, providing a response rate of 27%. The analyses presented in this report are based on the responses of the 207 respondents to the survey.

Respondent Profile

The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. There is 80 (39%) male and 127 (61%) female respondents in the survey sample. Most respondents are pursuing programs at the bachelor's degree level. The highest number (128) of respondents came from the Science (62%).

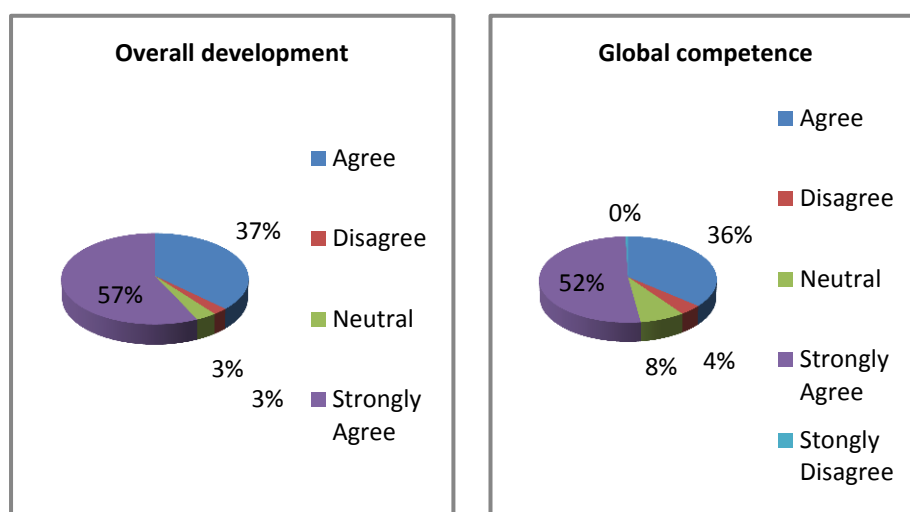


Overall Evaluation

Feedback was collected and analysed by Feedback Analysis Committee of the college. Opinion of the students is obtained about each parameter in percentage.

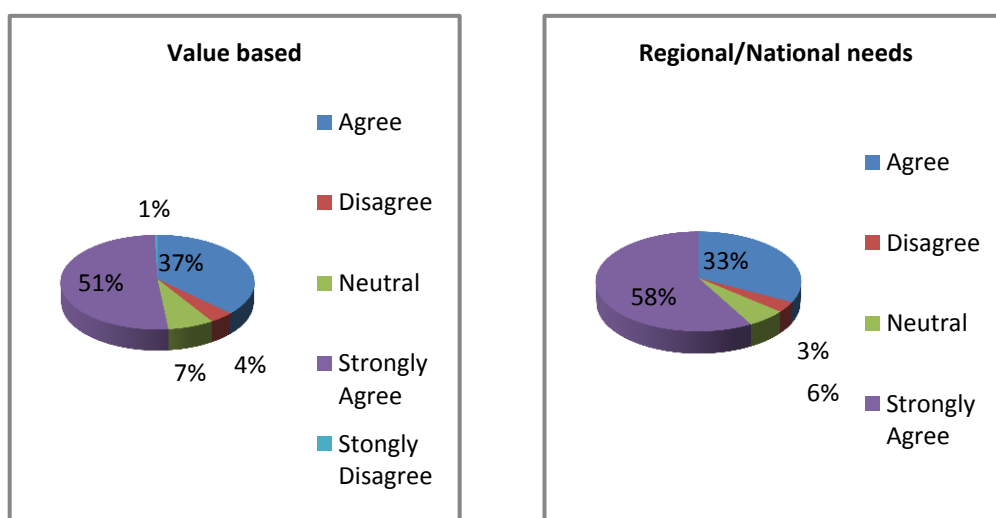
About 57% students strongly agree with curriculum design is suitable for meeting the overall development of students while 37% students were agree, 3% students showed neutral response while remaining 3% are disagree.

About 52% students strongly agree with curriculum develops the global competence of students while 36% students were agree, 8% students showed neutral response while remaining 4% are disagree.



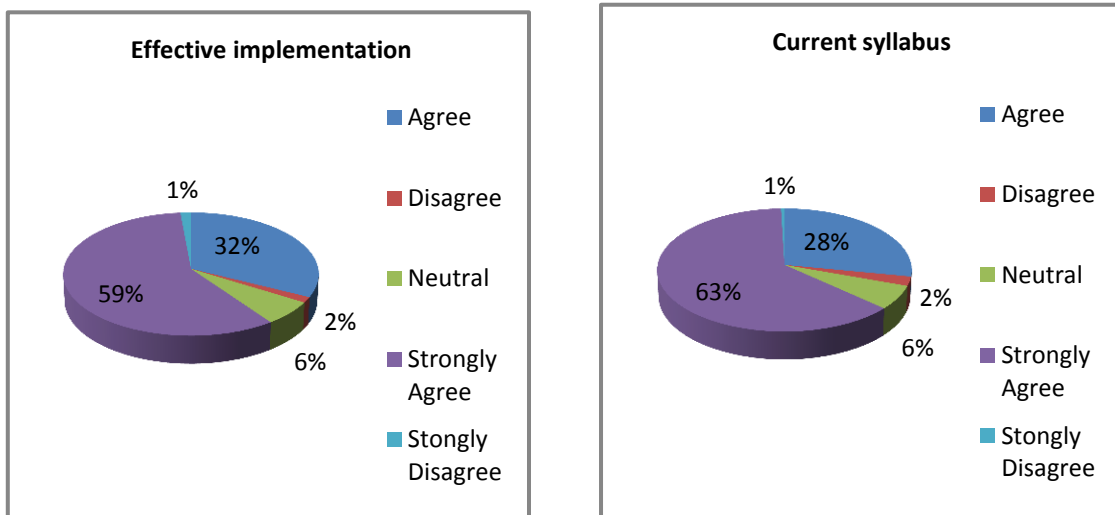
About 51% students strongly agree with curriculum design is value based while 37% students were agree, 7% students showed neutral response while remaining 4% are disagree and 1% strongly disagree.

About 52% students strongly agree with curriculum develops the global competence of students while 36% students were agree, 8% students showed neutral response while remaining 4% are disagree.



About 59% students strongly agree with action plans for effective implementation of the curriculum are very satisfactory while 32% students were agree, 6% students showed neutral response while remaining 2% are disagree and 1% strongly disagree.

About 63% students strongly agree with satisfaction about current syllabus while 28% students were agree, 6% students showed neutral response while remaining 2% are disagree and 1% strongly disagree.



Most of the students agree with the overall quality of teaching- learning process. Majority of the students are saying that most of the times teachers' can able to identify the weakness of the student. Based on their interactions with students, teachers identify the strength and weaknesses of the students and accordingly encourage them to participate in the various activities organized by department / college, Sanstha / University. This will help them in their overall development.



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
